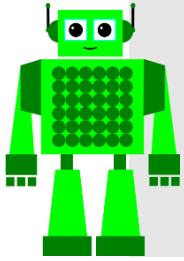


## Bullet Points

Key points to remember when using bullet points:

- At the end of the introductory sentence use a colon.
- If the bullet point is a complete sentence it needs to begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark.
- If the bullet point is not a full sentence, capital letters and punctuation are not used.
- Each new item in a list goes on a new line.
- Keep the style consistent and use either single words, phrases or full sentences.

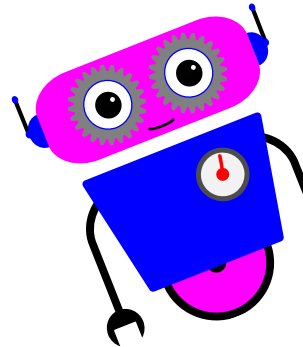
