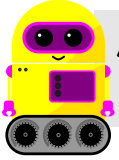


Compound Words

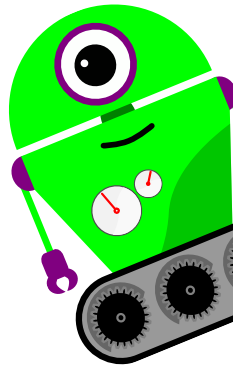
