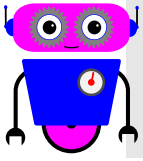


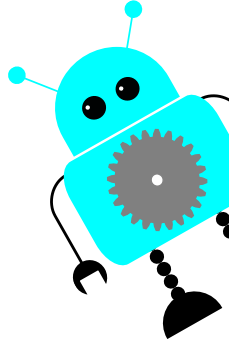
## Making adjectives by using the suffix -ful



A suffix is a group of letters that is added to the end of a word to make a new word. The suffix -ful means 'lots of' or 'full of'. Adding the suffix -ful changes a word into an adjective.
