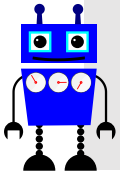


Making plurals by adding -s or -es



Plural means that there is more than one of something. For most nouns we add the suffix -s to make a plural. If a noun ends with a -s, -sh, -ch, -x or -z sound we add the suffix -es to make a plural.
One dog, two dogs. One witch, two witches.

2) Add the suffix -s or -es to make each noun into a plural.

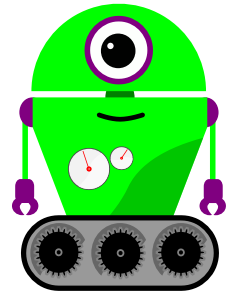
