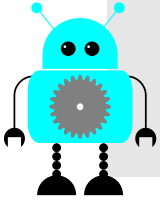


Nouns and Pronouns



A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun in a sentence. Examples of pronouns include he, she, they and it.

The bike was dirty so the bike was washed. The bike was dirty so it was washed.
Here the pronoun 'it' has been used to avoid repetition in the sentence.

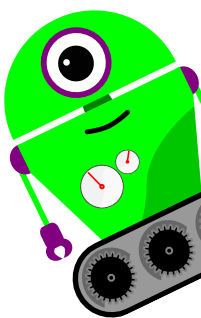
