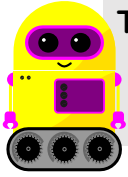


## Present and Past Tense



The present tense is used to show things that are happening now e.g. I walk to the shop. The past tense is used to show things that have already happened e.g. I walked to the shop.
