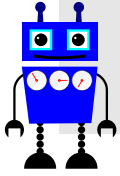


## Using the prefix un-

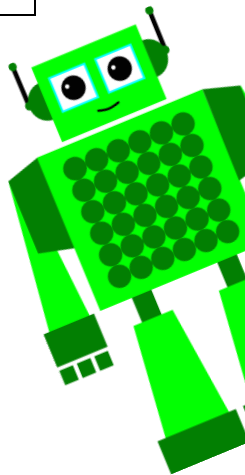
